c. APPROVE EXPANSION RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Greater Brunswick Charter School received a charter renewal from the State of New Jersey from the 2017/2018 to the 2021/2022 school year to operate a charter school in grades Kindergarten through Grade 8; and

WHEREAS, the Greater Brunswick Charter School is currently in its 21st year of operation;

WHEREAS, the Greater Brunswick Charter School has unique innovative educational programs including Personal Education Plans, Enrichment Clusters, Positive Discipline/Restorative Justice and a unique Dual Language Program which serves a primarily Spanish speaking community; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Education requires the submission of an amendment request to expand enrollment; and

WHEREAS, the Charter School has a waiting list in excess of 350 students distributed through all grades; and

WHEREAS, in order to serve the educational needs and demand of the community, and improve budgetary efficiencies, the charter school will need to increase each grade level to 48 students with a classroom average of 24 students for a total student count increase of 38 students from 394 students to 432;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Greater Brunswick Charter School Board of Trustees hereby approves and authorizes the application to amend its charter to permit the above described expansion of enrollment; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Administration is authorized to transmit this Resolution and supporting records to the Commissioner of Education and the New Brunswick, Highland Park, and Edison School Districts.
